GENERAL RULES VALENCIA FAIR MANAGEMENT COMPANY, INC.

- 1. Trailers are to be parked in designated parking spaces ONLY; no trailers may be parked inside the Gates. All Camper Trailers will be assessed a fee of \$15.00 a night or \$50.00 for the week. Written Permission must be obtained from VFMCI prior to the camper being set up. THERE ARE NO DUMPING FACILITIES OR ELECTRICITY PROVIDED.
- 2. All Indoor exhibits must be entered on August 18 and 19, 2024 between 12:00pm and 7:00pm.
- 3. Open indoor exhibits will be released between 12:00pm 3:00 PM on Sunday August 25, 2024. Exhibitors must be checked out with the Department Superintendent.
- 4. THERE WILL BE NO DOGS ALLOWED ON THE FAIRGROUNDS
- 5. The VFMCI reserves the final right to interpret these rules, settle and determine all matters, questions and differences regarding or connected with the Valencia County Fair.
- 6. In a case where no rule appears to cover a situation, the VFMCI will make a rule and define its application for such situations. General Rules and Regulations govern, but Special Rules of each Division take precedence over all other rules.
- 7. Any person who violates any VFMC rule will forfeit all privileges and premiums and be subject to such penalty as the governing body may order.
- 8. The VFMCI will employ security guards and will take every precaution for the safety of visitors and exhibits but assumes no liability for personal injury, loss or damage to any property or patron due to theft, fire, tornado, weather conditions or other causes.
- 9. Anyone desiring to make a complaint during the Fair may do so in the following manner:
 - (A) Write the complaint out in full detail and submit it to the Department Superintendent with a money order, cashier's check or cash for \$100 per complainant. No personal checks will be accepted.
 - (B) A minimum of five (5) board members will meet and give a ruling on your complaint. If the ruling goes in your favor, you will get your money back. If the ruling goes against you, the VFMC will retain the funds. This applies to all Departments.
 - (C) All complaints must be made prior to the start of the show in which the complaint pertains to.
- 10. National Code of Show Ring Ethics will be followed. See entry form for complete document and signature page.
- 11. Age requirements: Novice (9-11) or must be 8 and in the 3rd grade prior to January 1 of the current 4-H program year, Junior (12 -13) or 11 years and in 6th grade prior to January 1 of the current 4-H program year, Senior (14-19) or 13 and in the 8th grade but not have passed their 19th birthday prior to January 1 of the current 4-H program year.
